which came into the hands of James G Tate admr  
Sept 27th 1853**

[Estate inventory of William Anderson's (1802-1853) property. It surprising how much property was on a prosperous farm in the mid 1800s. William Anderson, his wife Martha Faucett (1805-1853), and son John Stanford Anderson (1839-1853), all died of typhoid fever within about 6 weeks in 1853. Presumably William Anderson had no will. The eldest child Martha Adaline Anderson (1827-1854) was married to James G. Tate.]
